Call for applications for FRDC investment in climate resilience and fishing and aquaculture research and development projects open until 15 February 2023.

The **Fisheries capacity building network** has recently been launched, creating an easily accessible program which allows participants to gain an understanding of contemporary fisheries management processes.

In time for the summer break, OzFish has launched **JuniorFishers** - a new program which sees children (ages 4 – 14) completing 10 unique challenges that educate, engage, and entertain. Each participant will receive a badge upon completion of a task.

The Northern Territory Seafood Council is calling for **expressions of interest in seafood processing**, to make the most of growing demand from Asian markets for Australia's highly regarded seafood.

Early next year, the **International Temperate Reefs Symposium** is being held in Hobart, being the premier conference for marine scientists looking to uncover more about temperate reef biology.

Collaboratively developed by government, fisheries and aquaculture sectors, **AQUAPLAN 2022-2027** is the fourth edition of the nation's plan to improve aquatic animal health systems.


