- provide information and services that are relevant to stakeholders
- minimise management, maintenance, and duplication of content
- have a feedback mechanism in place to enable timely response to both feedback and complaints
- provide readily available access to current and historical knowledge generated from FRDC research, development and extension investment activities (e.g. final reports)
- will be subject to periodic evaluation to ensure they are fit for purpose
- comply with relevant Commonwealth legislation and policies including but not limited to privacy, accessibility and records management
