REPORT TO F.I.R.T.A. N.S.W. FISHING GEAR WORKSHOP AND TRAWL AND DANISH SEINE WORKSHOF - APRIL 1977

A Fishing Gear Workshop and Trawl and Danish Seine Seminar organised by N.S.W. State Fisheries in April brought together 48 fishermen and industry and government representatives (See Appendix Fart 1).

The five day seminar programme included 25 papers spanning 3% days, an excursion aboard the F.R.V. "Kapala", a film night, a barbecue, and a visit to the U.S.A. Commercial Fishing Exhibition.

The aim of the seminar was to provide a means of communication between people associated with trawling and Danish seining as fish catching methods, and more specifically to help fishermen become more efficient and expert at their craft.

All participants were given extensive documentation including a copy of the 1974 Trawling Seminar Proceedings.

Topics covered included netting materials; design, construction and repair of nets, wire rope; chain; fish and prawn trawl designs; otterboard design and performance; trends in boat designs; deck and propulsion machinery; fish trawling practices; prawn trawling practices; and Danish seining practices. (See Appendix Part 2).

Speakers included 3 naval architects, 6 industry representatives, 4 fishermen who are leaders in their fields, and officers from N.S.W. State Fisheries and the Fisheries Division, Department of Frimary Industry.

The excursion aboard F.R.V. "Kapala" allowed time for an inspection of the ship and included demonstration of a midwater trawling equipment and a bottom prawn trawl.

An addition to the original agenda was a visit to the U.S.A. Commercial Fishing Exhibition, where a talk was given by Mr Burton Coffey, Senior Editor of "National Fisherman", and recent fishing gear was on display.

Copies of papers presented at the Workshop will be available through N.S.W. State Fisheries when they are published, and will be forwarded free of charge to the participants as well as to all trawl and Danish seine fishermen in New South Wales. Copies are also provided free on request to any Australian fishermen or organisation relating to the fishing industry.
