

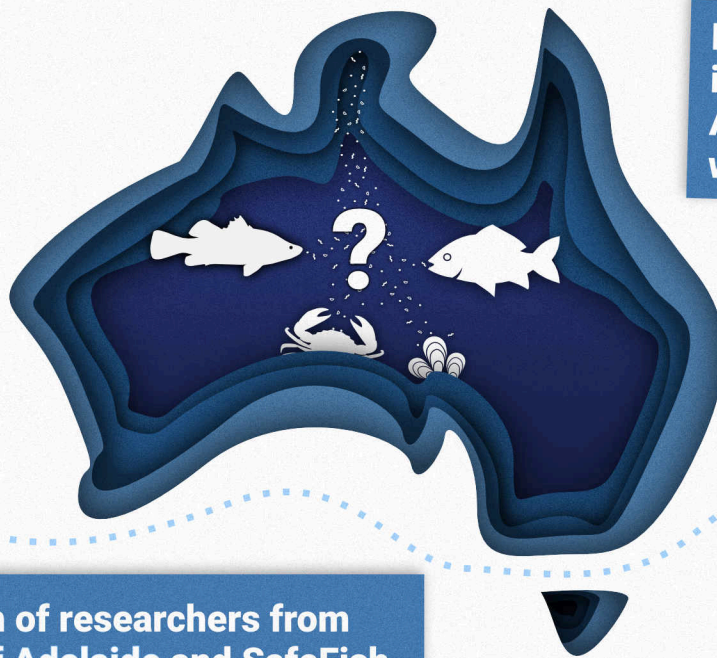
Are microplastics found in marine fish and invertebrates?

Plastic pollution is a major global issue

International studies show that microplastics (< 5 mm size) are particularly problematic because marine animals often mistake them for food.



But we don't know if this happens in Australian coastal waters...



Therefore a team of researchers from The University of Adelaide and SafeFish are going to figure this out.

The team will investigate if Australian iconic fish, crustaceans and shellfish contain microplastics in their gut.
